- 1. Purpose of Public Forum:** Youngtown is embarking on a comprehensive process to adopt its 2025 Parks, Open Space, Trails and Recreation Master Plan. Several public meetings will be held to discuss the Master Plan and obtain feedback from the public, members of Council, and community stakeholders.
- 2. Agenda/Discussion Topics:** Staff will lead discussion regarding the Master Plan, which may include assessment of existing sites and facilities, site and facility needs, existing recreation programming, existing recreation programming needs, formation of a regional park, regional park amenities, adjacent property owners, adjacent property owner needs, regional park design, and reading and analysis of the proposed 2025 Parks, Open Space, Trails and Recreation Master Plan.
- 3. Format:** The Public Forum will allow for public discussion and deliberation. Members of Council may attend the Public Forum and minutes will be taken if a quorum is in attendance. All members of the public are encouraged to attend and take part in this comprehensive planning process to assist staff and Council in creating a Master Plan that meets the community's needs.
